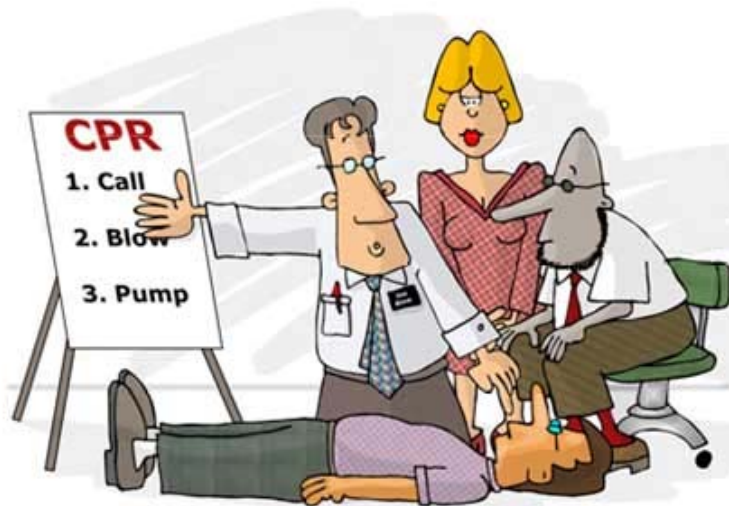

Each participant is evaluated individually on his/her ability to demonstrate core course knowledge and skills. This course will prepare you to work as a team member and team leader in a code situation. Participants must have the textbook ahead of time and complete the Pre-course Preparation Checklist in the Provider Manual. This includes the online self-assessment. Participants who are interested in a review of ECG's and ACLS Pharmacology are strongly encouraged to first attend an ACLS Prep course. AHA requires that all students have a book at class with them. 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Chemotherapy and Biotherapy - ONS

This course is designed specifically for the Registered Nurse working in Oncology. We will utilize material and curriculum published by the Oncology Nursing Society (ONS) to verify that participants have the didactic knowledge necessary to practice at the bedside with an experienced chemo RN. Individual facilities are responsible for validating chemo administration competency. Topics covered will include the pathophysiology of cancer, diagnosis, legal & ethical issues and patient teaching. Significant course time will also be spent on common chemotherapeutic agents, administration of chemotherapy and biotherapy, the effect of chemo on body systems and safety measures. Upon completion, participants will receive an ONS Chemotherapy Provider Card valid for 2 years. The textbook fee of \$80.00 is included in the course fee. SIX MONTHS OF NURSING EXPERIENCE IS REQUIRED FOR THIS COURSE (NO NEW GRADS PLEASE). Both days must be attended for credit. PLEASE BRING A HIGHLIGHTER, A CALCULATOR AND A PACKET OF POST-IT NOTES TO CLASS.

S.T.A.B.L.E. stands for Sugar, Temperature, Airway, Blood Pressure, Labwork, and Emotional support-all necessary components of stabilizing ill infants.

Wound Care for the Healthcare Professional
